### **CASS CITY TO CREATE PATRIOTIC MOSAIC MURAL FOR AMERICA'S 250TH**

The Village of Cass City has received a grant from the ***Frankenmuth Credit Union Foundation for Our Communities***, to acquire a 7'x12' mural mosaic kit featuring an American flag and bald eagle, to be painted by community members and displayed on the Village's Municipal Building.

"As we approach the Semiquincentennial of the United States, also known as America250, we had wanted to take on a community project that reflected our citizens sense of pride and patriotism," states Debbie Powell, Village Manager.

A community planning workshop took place in October 2025, in which several residents reflected on their interest in seeing public art in our downtown district. An idea was born and research was done to find a mural that incorporates the participation of its community members. The selected mural will feature 200 individual tiles, to be painted by volunteers from Cass City. Interested people will be able to complete a form for consideration and a random drawing will take place to select painters.

Powell added that a community painting day is scheduled to take place on Saturday, February 28, at the Cass City VFW Hall. Painters will work side-by-side to create their

images on the tiles, and village staff will assemble them into a mural to be displayed at the center of downtown Cass City, on the west side of the Municipal Building.

"Our hope is that this mural will serve not only as a visual enhancement to our downtown, but also as a lasting symbol of unity, pride and respect for those who have contributed to the past 250 years of our nation," says Powell.
